Position: Full-Time Firefighter/EMT

Pay: Grade 17B or 18C (based on experience/qualifications)

The Springfield Fire Department is accepting applications for the position of Firefighter/EMT. This is a full-time, benefited position. The successful candidate will join an “all hazards” department that responds to incidents including but not limited to: Structure Fires, Hazardous Materials Incidents, Technical Rescues involving Water/Ice/Ropes, Motor Vehicle Accidents, Emergency Medical Calls, Paramedic Intercepts and Wildland Fires.

Minimum Qualifications:

- High School diploma or GED is required. Preferred is a college education within a degree program with a minimum of 60 credits accumulated as an educational base.
- A current, maintained Vermont Firefighter1 or Pro-Board Certified equivalent. Firefighter II attained within 18 months of hire.
- At minimum, a current Nationally Registered EMT license. A Nationally Registered Advanced-EMT license must be obtained within 12 months of hire.
- A current, valid Candidate Physical Agility Test (CPAT) card. If this is not current, you’ll have 12 months from hire to obtain.
- Valid motor vehicle operator’s license.
- Ability to comprehend and follow written and verbal orders and instruction.
- Ability to act in a professional manner in both emergency and non-emergency situations.
- Physical capacity to perform the duties required by the position as indicated by tests and/or physical examination upon hiring and recertified per Collective Bargaining Agreement. Yearly medical physical as required by OSHA to meet 29CFR, 1910.134. Successfully passing a pre-employment physical is required.
- Successful completion of a 12 month probationary period, which may be extended at the discretion of the Fire Chief.
